DAY 5: WAIT

PSALMS W/A SCIENTIST

NOTE: ROCK CANDY SHOULD ONLY BE MADE WITH ADULT SUPERVISION!

To make TWO rock candies, you will need:

- a saucepan
- 3 cups of sugar
- 1 cup water
- Food coloring
- ½ teaspoon Flavoring (optional)
- Two sticks (like cake pop stick, skewer, pipe cleaner or string) (listed in order of desirability)
- Two (10-ounce) Mason jars with lids
- Two clothespins

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Prepare the stick

- a. Dip at least 4 inches of the stick in water
- b. Roll the stick in sugar
- c. Set aside to dry a little
- 2. Pour water in saucepan and add sugar. Stir.
- 3. Heat sugar solution over medium heat until the mixture comes to a boil
- 4. Take pan off the heat and add in food coloring and flavoring (if desired) and stir
- 5. Let the sugar solution cool for at least 10 minutes
- 6. Divide the sugar solution into two Mason jars
- 7. Use only the rim part of the lids and attach them to the jars

8. Use the clothespins to support the prepared sticks in the sugar solution. Do not let the stick touch the bottom of the jar. Leave ½ inch of space between the end of the stick and the bottom of the jar.

9. Place the jars where they will not be disturbed.

10. Check them each day

TIPS:

- While crystals should mostly be undisturbed, a little maintenance is required while they grow.
- The goal is for the crystals to form on the stick but sugar crystals will grow everywhere in the solution.
- Watch that the stick does not become "stuck" to either the bottom of the jar or the sides. You may need to break up the crystals on the surface from time to time and gently wiggle the stick to ensure it is not stuck to the bottom of the jar.

ICE PAINTING

MATERIALS: an ice cube tray (or small plastic containers), popsicle sticks (you'll be fine without, it'll just be cold), food coloring, water and white paper (the thicker the better). Ice paint will act as watercolor, so thicker paper will be better. You can also paint outside on the sidewalk for a mess free experience.




STEP 1 – pour water into your ice cube tray


