## DAY 1: "LICHT"

#### STORY:

• Tortilla Chips (or other snack) and salt (optional)

#### **SCIFNCF**:

- Light source such as a flashlight
- Aluminum foil
- A variety of different materials around the house like a towel, smooth wood, tile, brick, plastic, shiny metal, water, mirror

#### CRAFT:

- White paper
- Markers
- Scissors
- Scotch tape
- Measuring tape (optional)
- Two pieces of white
- One piece of yellow construction paper
- Glue
- Markers

#### CAMF:

Flashlight or lamp

### DAY 2: "FFAR"

#### STORY:

None

#### SCIFNCF:

- Light source such as a flashlight
- Small toy or object
- Piece of wax paper (about 5" x 5")
- Piece of tissue paper (about 5" x 5")
- Piece of aluminum foil (about 5" x 5")
- Piece of plastic wrap (about 5" x 5")
- Note card (3" x 5")
- Data Table (provided in resources on webpage: mungerplace.org/vbs)

#### CRAFT:

- Construction paper
- Markers
- Glue (optional)
- Cardboard box (optional)

### **CAMF**:

- Balloons
- Scissors
- Bible verse print out

# DAY 3: "SHELTER"

#### STORY:

- Rock
- Bowl of sand or dirt

#### **SCIFNCF**:

- Paper towels
- Tray (the one I will use is a 10 ½ inch x 13 ½ inch plastic tray)
- A clear, 2-liter bottle (or to create an even larger worm habitat, use a clear storage bin)
- Black-and-white newspaper
- Dirt from the yard or garden
- A spray bottle with tap water
- Small shovel
- Worms

(You can dig them up in the ground OR buy them (about \$3.00) at Walmart or a bait shop. If you buy worms (recommended) choose Night Crawlers or Red Wrigglers)

# DAY 4: "SEEK"

**STORY:** the objective is to find as many objects as they can in a set amount of time. They do NOT need to find all these objects and do not need to gather them ahead of time.

- Something orange
- Something spikey
- Something long
- Something that tastes good
- Something that smells good

#### SCIENCE:

- Refrigerator magnets (the stronger, the better)
- Paper clips (at least 10)
- A variety of materials such as coins (quarter, dime, nickel and penny), different kinds of wood, aluminum foil, a metal spoon, a plastic spoon, straw, buttons, Legos, rubber band, cotton ball (small objects made of different kinds of materials at least 10)

#### CRAFT:

- Cardstock or paper
- Pen
- Markers
- Assorted stickers
- Envelope
- Stamp

## DAY 5: "WAIT"

### STORY:

A favorite snack

#### SCIENCE:

- Salt Crystals:
  - water
  - salt (one teaspoon)
  - small bowl (preferably clear)
- Alum Crystals (optional)
  - alum (one tablespoon) (found in grocery stores in the spice section)
  - water
  - small bowl (preferably clear)
- Rock Candy
  - Rock Candy Instructions (provided in resources on webpage: mungerplace.org/vbs)
  - sugar (3 cups)
  - food coloring
  - flavoring like lemon, coconut, strawberry (optional)
  - water
  - two (12-oz) jars with rims
  - clothespin
  - stick (like skewer, cake pop stick, pipe cleaner, or string)

#### CRAFT:

- Recipe and ingredients for your favorite cookies
- Ice cube tray
- Popsicle sticks
- Food coloring
- Water
- White paper (the thicker the better)

#### **CAME:**

Playdough
